- Open to all young British dancers between the ages of 14 and 18 years inclusive on 1st January 2010.
- Candidates will be expected to take part on stage before an audience in a Classical Ballet Class at Elementary Standard and above.
- Selected finalists will be invited to perform a 2 minute Classical Ballet Solo of their own choice, suitably costumed, but not to include known classical repertoire. Finalists will be expected to provide their own live or taped accompaniment for their solos
- The Solo should show the candidate’s ability to use their technique to create and transmit emotion.
